8. CANADIAN VETERAN TARTAN PROPOSAL

An unsolicited submission was received by the RCL for adopting a "Veteran Tartan". The Chair presented arguments based on historical and used of this item of dress. The Committee also noted that the RCL dress policies are meant for RCL members and not individual on their own based on their status. The RCL membership is made up of more than Veterans and therefore should not have dress article that would not be available for wear to certain group within the Legion. The membership agreed that this endeavour, albeit well meant, is not one that the RCL can support. With the Committee membership in agreement, the Chair will forward the recommendations to the National Executive for a response.

9. LEGION DRESS

The Chair brought this point as information only. Queries to have changes made to the RCL dress, protocol or other topics related to Ritual and Award have often tried to make their way to the Committee by way of telephone or email means versus being staffed thru using the proper and official Resolution process. The Chair reiterated that no such request will be entertained or discussed unless they are received thru the proper channels set by the RCL By-Laws and policies.

10.PORTRAITS

A query was made as to an RCL policy that dictate the display of a poppies on the frame of a Past President that have passed (as done at legion House) or Maple Leaf for Associate Members. The Chair confirmed that there is no such specific policy and what is done is on an historical and traditional basis. The Committee is unanimous in carrying this practice and no formal policies are required to be developed on this topic.

11.CENTENARY

The Chair mentioned that the final design of the RCL centennial medal has been completed, and draft circulated before being formally adopted by DEC.

12. CANADIAN UNITY PROPOSAL

An unsolicited submission was made to the Committee following the wave of Patriotism now predominant throughout the country considering the difficult relationship presently experienced between Canada and the United States. To that end, it was requested to approve the wearing of a Canada Flag pin on Legion Dress for a period to come. The Committee was unanimous in support of this submission and will present a motion for DEC decision at the April meeting.
