3. DIGITAL ELECTRONIC MEMBERSHIP CARD - UPDATE

The committee Assistant Coordinator updated the progress being made on the new digital card

- The launch has been delayed slightly and is scheduled for early in the new year
- Card downloadable to a mobile wallet
- Available for both new and renewing Legion members
- When ready to launch the card will launch with a stand -alone All Branch email to all Branches to communicate processes.

4. UPDATE ON THE VETERAN FAMILY WELCOME PROGRAM

Currently there are 335 members signed up for the new program. The program was launched with an independent All Branch email. Expectations are for 2,000 new members by the end of 2022.

The Committee suggested the expansion of the program to include the parents and guardians of CF and RCMP members.

In addition, it was suggested Silver Cross Parents receive a 'honoury Life Membership' The Coordinator will bring both suggestions to the Membership Committee for further consideration.

The updated Application form is now available on the membership website. The online Join process has also been updated.

6. UPDATE: BRANCH MEMBERSHIP PAYMENTS TO DOMINION COMMAND

The Dominion Finance Team is working towards streamlining Branch Per Capita Membership Payments to improve efficiencies and reduce growing Branch accounts receivables and has communicated a move to eliminating accepting cheques by the end of 2022. As this plan continues to be developed with Provincial Commands the following is for clarification purposes:

Until further notice:

- Memberships processed on the portal can be paid by the Branch using a credit card (preferred method of payment) <u>or</u> by cheque mailed to Dominion Membership
- All memberships processed manually (not on the portal) can be paid by credit card (over the phone) or by cheque mailed to Dominion Membership
- Cheques will continue to be accepted until other options of payment outside of VISA and MASTERCARD have been explored, tested, implemented, and fully communicated (target end of 2022)
- <u>Please Do Not</u> send Membership Payments via Direct Deposit/Electronic Fund Transfer or E-Transfer. We are unable to accept these payments
- Direct Deposit/Electronic Fund Transfer payments are only used to transfer funds from Dominion Command to Branches (Membership, Poppy etc.)**NOT**...for Branches sending funds to Dominion Command

As we continue to work with Provincial Commands towards other Branch Membership payment options, we will keep all updated.

- We need to provide better visibility with the Military Family Resource Centres
- Greater Course briefingsNational graduation centres.....transition centres.....
- We need to publicize and share our service bureau stats ...to show the tremendous work being done on behalf of our Veterans
- Celebrate our successes to show the impact the Legion is having with financial and volunteer commitments
- Target more of our Marketing towards female Veterans
- Focus on recruit centres....new potential members entering the CF i.e St Jean
- Strong communication to Branch level about these programs is critical
- Greater Outreach to Cadets
- Homeless Vets.....greater focus and emphasis
- It was suggested New veterans want us to change....eliminate our Legion medals and liquor in the Legions, let them become part of Branch Executive
- Let local Legions provide a specific space to allow Veterans to meet with each other.....some 'Buddy Checks' operate this way....maybe a separate Veterans Day at the local Legion
- Continue to be progressive.....Encourage and promote 1st female Branch president in local history....review some potentially outdated local club rules (wearing of ball caps)
- Promote the Youth programs within the Legion
- Legion Recruiting Poster'We need a whole lot of good Veterans to join the Legion'
- Mea culpa letter.....'This is not your grandfathers Legion'...Admit we have made some mistakes.....WW1 vets didn't welcome WW2 vets ...WW2 vets didn't welcome others.
