## **7. LEGION NATIONALS VIP PROTOCOL**

The sports committee discussed VIP protocol during the Legion National Youth Track and Field Championships. In accordance with the Dominion Sports Guide, the Local

Arrangements Committee is responsible for arranging a host hotel for VIPs (822.a) and setting up a viewing area / tent at the competition venue (824.d). These requirements will be met at each Legion Nationals. In addition, the organizing committee seeks to provide attending VIPs with airport transport to and from the venue. It was also noted that VIPs may be invited to sub-events (receptions, opening ceremonies, closing banquet, etc) depending on the partnership agreement.

VIPs and Provincial Representatives are also provided the opportunity to present medals to athletes as part of the medal ceremonies. The sports committee will ensure that these limited spots are distributed fairly.

Finally, it was noted that in accordance with the Dominion Sports Guide section 710, Provincial Commands are encouraged to send a representative to the championships and are responsible for all expenses.
