Legion releases Poppy Trust Fund figures for 2023

The Royal Canadian Legion Branch 561 in Elliot Lake released its figures for its Poppy Trust Fund for 2023. Al Warman, Royal Canadian Legion in Elliot Lake past president and chair of the Poppy Trust Fund, says the local 2023 Poppy Trust Fund started in Jan. 1, 2023 \$34,586.81, plus the income from the campaign and other sources of \$22,052.00 for a total of

During the year they had expenses such as purchasing poppies and wreaths for resale in the amount of \$2,113.06, plus adverting costs of \$188, and other expenses of \$101.42, for a total of \$2,402.48.

In addition, they gave grants to veteran and their families amounting to \$1,375.34, plus \$1,000 in high school bursaries, and donations amounting to \$19,845.94, along with \$550 for youth education programs from a total of \$22,771.28. The total of the disbursement of the expenses, grants, bursaries donations and youth education program was \$25,173.76. As a result, as of Dec. 31, 2023, the Legion had a total of \$31,465.05 in the branch's Poppy Trust Fund, explains Warman.

My son currently serves in the Canadian Army Reserve and took his dress uniform in last week for tailoring at 17 Wing. Unfortunately when he got back home his dress pants were missing from his garment bag. He went Monday back to 17 Wing but was informed that his pants could not be found. He would have to order pants online and would be five business days. He started to panic as Remembrance Day was a week away and there was no guarantee his new pants would arrive in time. Being a veteran myself, I reached out to fellow veterans that I knew to try and see if anyone had a pair they could lend but unfortunately that turned out flat. Even a retired supply technician from 17 Wing reached out to the supply technicians at 17 Wing to search again but no luck.

My son was concerned that he was going to face disciplinary action for not having his proper uniform for the special day of Nov. 11. I happened to be driving to work on Sargent Thursday morning and remembered there was a surplus store there called Marway Militaria. I waited for them to open and called them explaining my son's dilemma. I was told they would look in the warehouse and get back to me later in the afternoon to see if they had anything in his size.

I received a call later that day at approximately 17:00 letting me know they had a couple of pairs in his size and would hold them for him. My son was beside me and, though normally stoic, was instantly relieved with an expression on his face like he just won the lottery. He agreed to pick them up Friday morning.

When I asked how much he owes them, they simply replied "nothing." I asked again saying it took time away from other customers and it's their business to sell this stuff. I was told "we can't charge a young soldier for trying to do his duty on a special day." I was speechless. I asked if there was anything else we can do. They responded with "you can make a donation to our in-store Legion poppy fund if you choose." I indicated my son would be happy with that.

I was so impressed with this simple gesture that this business made to help a veteran help his current serving son that I just had to share.
