5. 2026 & 2027 LEGION NATIONAL YOUTH TRACK AND FIELD CHAMPIONSHIPS HOST SELECTION

The Dominion Sports Committee conducted an extensive and detailed review of all the bids in order to ensure a fair and detailed selection process. Based on the evaluation of the bids in accordance with the evaluation criteria in the bid handbook, the Sports Committee moved to select the winning bid.

MOTION: It was moved to award the hosting of the 2026 and 2027 Legion Nationals Youth Track and Field Championships to Regina, Saskatchewan.
